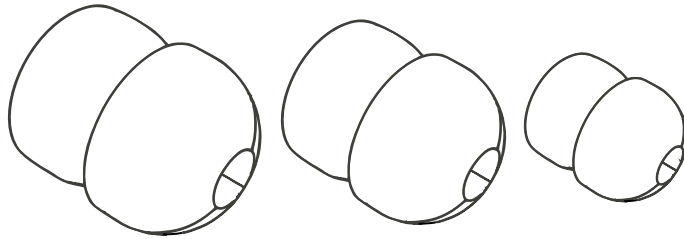




SPL2

dB Logic uses SPL2 -- short for Sound Pressure Level Limiting -- to keep the volume below dangerous levels. SPL2 does not require any adjustments, batteries, or programming -- it works automatically and is always on. SPL2 Keeps the maximum sound pressure at a level high enough to capture the full feeling of great music while also helping to ensure a lifetime of listening by reducing the chance of noise induced hearing loss.



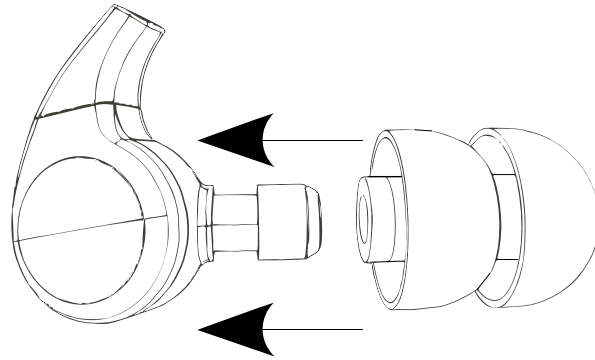

Select the proper size eartips

Three different sizes of eartip are included, in pairs. Select the size that provides a snug, sealed fit to your ear. If the eartips are too loose, the sound quality will not be as good.

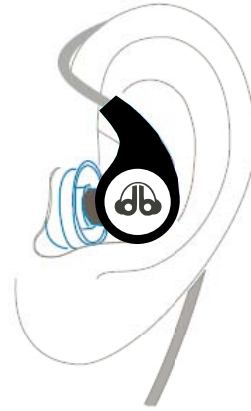


Attach eartips fully

Each eartip must be fully installed on the earpiece. Push each tip on until it is securely captured by the stem of the earpiece.



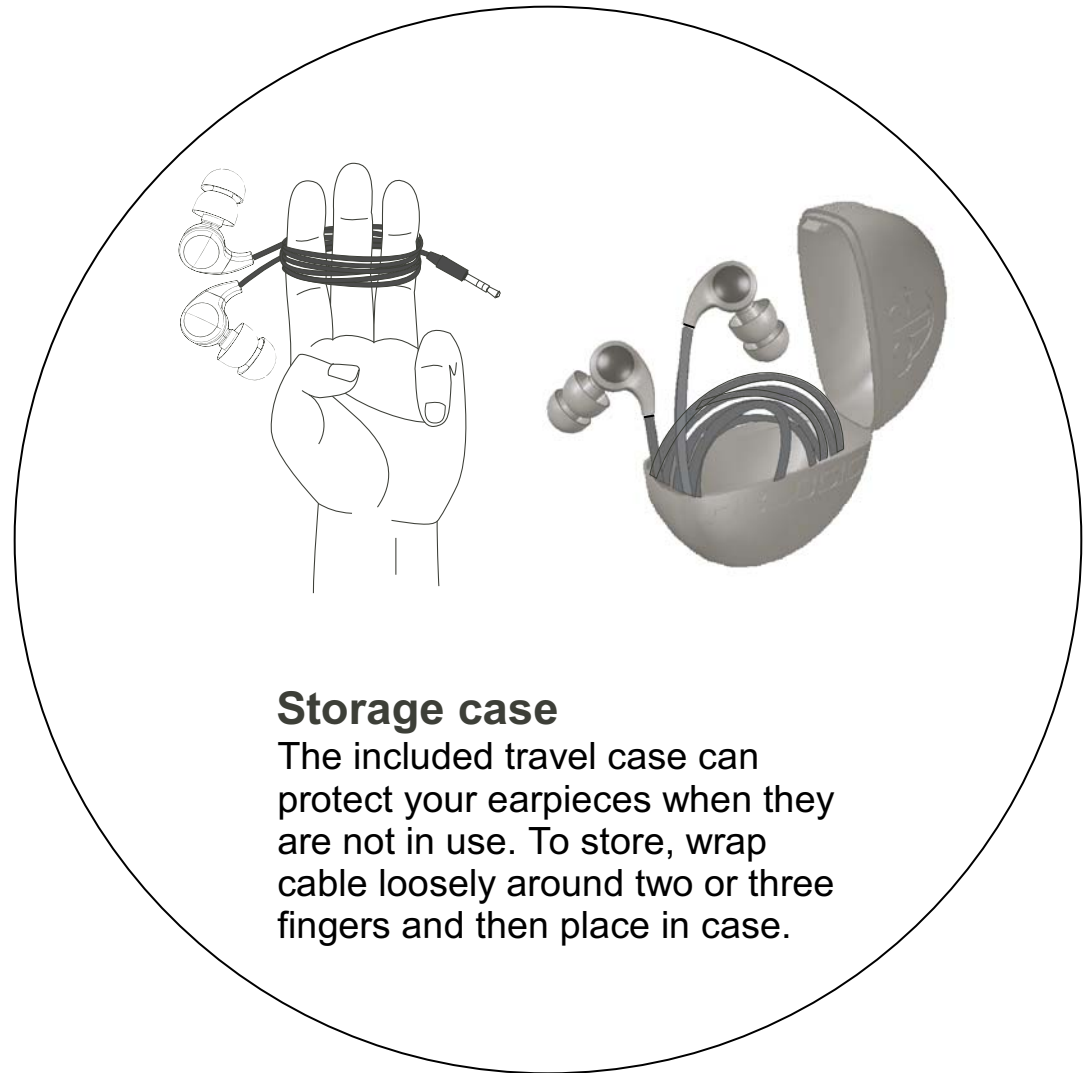
Straight down



Behind-the-ear


Insert in ears

Earpieces can be worn with cable behind the ear or with cable straight down. Behind the ear style is recommended for active use and optimum comfort.



Storage case

The included travel case can protect your earpieces when they are not in use. To store, wrap cable loosely around two or three fingers and then place in case.



Stop listening if you experience ringing in your ears or ear fatigue.
